| 1. | NéPriCa Negromaro and Primitivo gives a traditional Italian wine beefed up with the superstar Cabernet Sauvignon. With bags of fruit and a touch of liquorice on the palate this wine has great depth. | £ 20.50 |
| 2. | Primitivo, Itynera Incredibly fruity and satisfying, though remaining uncomplicated and very enjoyable. | £ 15.95 |
| 3. | Barbera d'Asti Fiulot, Alfred Prunotto Fragrant on the nose with hints of plum and cherry. On the palate it is well structured and soft, showing the typical red fruit and bright character of the Barbera variety. | £ 22.50 |
| 4. | Chianti Classico Peppoli, Antinori Made from the Primitivo grape, known as Zinfandel in the USA, this wine is intense and complex, perfect with red meats. | £ 33.95 |
| 5. | Regaleali Nero d'Avola, Tasca d'Almerita The vibrant red fruit on the initial taste moves onto deeper, darker, more complex fruit on the mid palate. This is a cracking modern style of a traditional Sicilian wine. | £ 20.95 |
| 6. | Bonacosta Valpolicella Classico, Masi Valpolicella is an Italian legend, brilliant in colour and in flavour, intense red fruit flavours and a mellow velvety finish. | £ 23.95 |
| 7. | Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Fattoria La Valentina First-class peppery Montepulciano, with all the exuberant fruit and spicy character of the grape, plus an extra degree of refinement from this excellent producer. | £ 23.50 |
| 8. | Angelo Nero d'Avola/Sangiovese Fresh, juicy Sicilian red blending the cherry aromas of Sangiovese with the spicy richness of Nero d'Avola, giving long-lasting, succulent flavour. | £ 15.50 |

| 9. | Passo Doble (Malbec/Corvina), Masi Fragrant and complex on the nose with ripe fruit aromas enhanced by notes of prune and liquorice. Up-front and powerful on the palate with hints of spice and and cooked cherries followed by a long appetizing finish. | Argentina | £ 22.50 |
| 10. | Merlot Reserva Gran Hacienda, Santa Rita Juicy blackberry and plum flavours, the trademark of a ripe Merlot, are wrapped around a velvet texture and touch of oak. | Chile | £ 18.95 |
| 11. | Rioja Crianza Conde de Valdemar, Bodegas Valdemar Intense cherry red colour, deep and fine aroma with excellent fruit and hints of good ageing in wood. | Spain | £ 23.75 |
| 12. | Pinot Noir Coopers Creek, Marlborough Black plums and black cherries on the nose intermingled with subtle French oak and nuances of grilled meat. Rich and firm on the palate with bold, sweet fruit. A core of ripe black cherry lingers on the finish. | New Zealand | £ 25.75 |

| 13. | Costasera Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Masi Made using an ancient technique for drying grapes to increase their sugar content, the palate is bursting with ripe, pure cherry fruit on a long finish. | Italy | £ 43.50 |
| 14. | Barolo Classico, Prunotto This wine of the Nebbiolo grape is aged for long periods before release, to provide a great concentration of red fruit on the palate and complex floral aromas on the nose. | Italy | £ 43.50 |
| 15. | Brunello di Montalcino Pian delle Vigne Intense cherry red colour, deep and fine aroma with excellent fruit and hints of good ageing in wood. | Italy | £ 55.00 |
| 16. | Château Côtes de Gros Caillou St Emilion, Bordeaux Intense aromas of ripe red fruits mingled with vanilla notes. Well-balanced structure and a silky mouthfeel make for a delicious yet distinguished claret. | France | £ 30.50 |

| 17. | Casasole Orvieto Classico Amabile The traditional style of Orvieto, for those who like their wine fruity and a little sweet. | £ 18.95 |
| 18. | Chardonnay Tormaresca, Puglia IGT Bright, fruity, medium-bodied Chardonnay showing the purity and richness of Puglian fruit. | £ 20.50 |
| 19. | Masianco (Pinot Grigio/Verduzzo), Venezie IGT, Masi Refreshing hints of citrus fruits and apricots on the nose. Easy-drinking qualities on the front palate give way to greater depth, with flavours of ripe apples and a slight touch of honey. Long and dry on the finish. | £ 23.50 |
| 20. | Pinot Grigio Trentino Castel Firmian Fresh, crisp fruit with just a hint of smokiness. A very clean well defined flavour and refreshing dry finish. | £ 19.50 |
| 21. | Frascati Superiore, Gotto d'Oro A clean, fresh wine, though slightly more weighty than the traditional, the palate is crisp and dry with a lingering, tangy finish. | £ 16.95 |
| 22. | Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico, Fattoria Laila A delicate, citrusy nose with hints of wild flowers leads to a lively, elegant palate that combines citrus zest and almond. Crisp, dry and satisfying. | £ 20.50 |
| 24. | Grillo / Sauvignon Blanc Itynera, Sicilia IGT This blend of Sicilian Sauvignon Blanc with the island's traditional Grillo grape gives a fresh wine with notes of citrus and tropical fruit and a round, harmonious palate | £ 15.50 |

| 27. | Dry Riesling Columbia Valley, Château Ste Michelle A dry, crisp, refreshing style of Riesling with beautiful forward fruit flavours, white peach and mandarin, and a clean finish. | USA | £ 23.95 |
| 28. | Petit Chablis, Domaine J-M Brocard White fruit and crystallized citrus aromas on the nose, then a lively palate with notes of flowers leading on to a slightly mineral finish. | France | £ 25.95 |

| 30. | Gavi de Gavi La Meirana, Bruno Broglia Great texture and precision, with distinctive green apple and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi. | Italy | £ 27.50 |
| 31. | Nozze d'Oro (Inzolia/Sauvignon Blanc), Tasca d'Almerita With apple, peach, melon and honey aromas, and a sleek, well-defined palate, this is crisp and refreshing like no other Sicilian white. | Italy | £ 35.50 |
| 32. | Sancerre Les Boffants, Charles Dupuy A classic Sancerre, with aromas of currants and grapefruit, a dry, elegant palate with a layer of minerality, and a neat, focused finish. | France | £ 34.95 |

| 34. | Rotari Brut Metodo Classico Cuvée 28, Mezzacorona Impressive traditional-method fizz, with great depth of flavour, pure apple fruit, and a fine mousse from twenty-eight months' on the lees. | Italy | £ 24.50 |
| 35. | Rotari Rosé Classico, Mezzacorona An elegant sparkling rose, dry fresh and fruity with a fine persistent finish. Made to the champagne mould in Italy, this is a wonderfully balanced fizz. | Italy | £ 24.50 |
| 36. | Champagne Deutz Brut Classic NV A definitive non-vintage blend, with equal proportions Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pino Meunier rounded by 20-40% reserve wines. Delicate and floral on the nose, this champagne exudes ripe fruit flavours and full bodied elegance. | France | £ 50.00 |
